Nearly 70 archaeological sites document a remarkable and varied history that goes back thousands of years at JPPM. Through this special guided hike, visitors can learn about the 9,000 years of human history uncovered by the archaeology carried out on the park and visit an active archaeology site to witness the process first hand.

The hike will end at the Maryland Archaeological Conservation Lab, located on the park. Participants should pack a lunch to enjoy after the hike, since there are no food amenities on the park. Following lunch, a guided tour of the lab will be offered.

Please note this is an approximately 2-hour, 2.5 mile hike on various surfaces/elevations, and can be strenuous for new hikers. Dress comfortably and bring plenty of water, as there are no fountains along hike.
